Our learning journeys Autumn Term



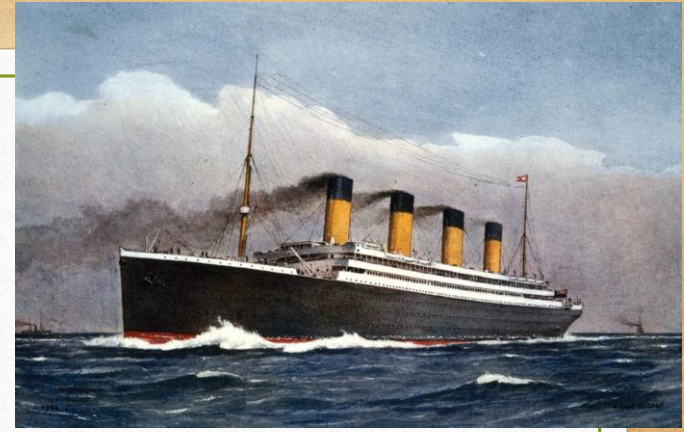

In the first term our topic is called Maafa. This project teaches you about Africa past and present and the development of the slave trade. As part of our work we will also look at great black Britons in the 20th century.



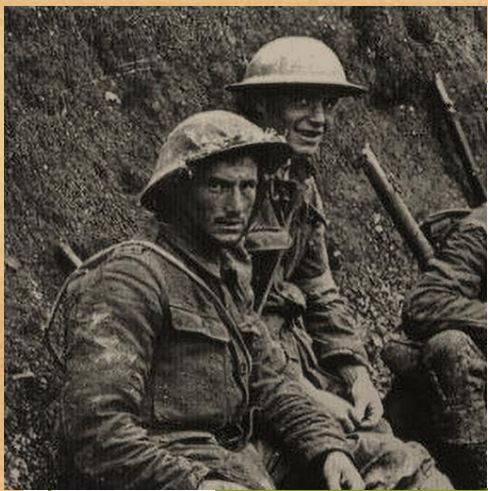


Our learning journeys Spring Term



Our topic will be Frozen Kingdoms where we will look at icebergs. We will identify polar regions and how we can protect them. Diving into history, we will investigate famous explorers.





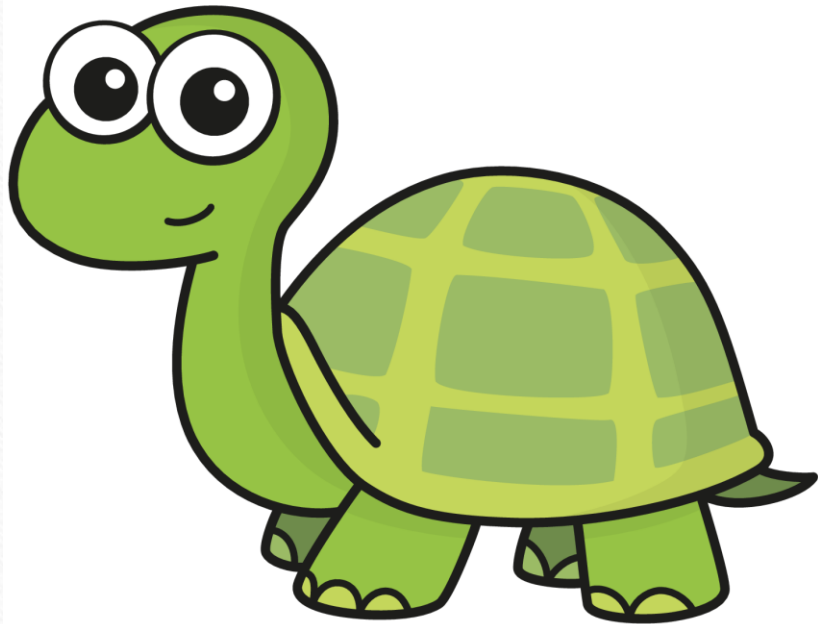
Our learning journeys Summer Term



Our topic will be Britain at War where we will learn about the main causes of the First World War and which countries were the major players. We will investigate why so many men volunteered to fight and then sequence the events at the start of the war. The children will also learn about the causes and main events of the Second World War and about the Battle of Britain and how it proved to be a key turning point for the Allied Powers. They will also hear about Anne Frank and discover what her story tells us about the treatment of Jewish people by the Nazi Party.
